8" Wide x 26" Long	Yarn needle Scissors
<b>YARN</b>	<b>GAUGE</b>
CotLin™ (DK, 70% Tanguis Cotton, 30% Linen; 123yds/50g): 25328 Whisper, 3 skeins	17 sts and 13.5 rows = 4" over Half Double Crochet

US H/7 (4.5mm) Crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

## Blissful Hair Towel

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### Pattern Intro

The Blissful Hair Towel is a classic hair towel with a simple half double crochet design that features a gorgeous front post, back post stitch along the base of the hair towel. The post stitch twists its way through the hair towel when it's wrapped around the head.

### Techniques

This pattern is crocheted from the bottom up and decreased accordingly. You crochet two individual panels and then single crochet them together, making it super simple.

### Pattern Notes

Chains at start of row do not count as a stitch.

### Special Stitches

#### Front Post Double Crochet (FPDC)

YO, insert hook from front to back to front around indicated st, YO, pull up a lp, [YO, draw through 2 lps on hook] 2 times.

#### Back Post Double Crochet (BPDC)

YO, insert hook from back to front to back around indicated st, YO, pull up a lp, [YO, draw through 2 lps on hook] 2 times.

#### Half Double Crochet Decrease (HDC-dec)

Worked over 3 sts: YO, insert hook into indicated st, YO pull through, [insert hook into next st, YO pull through] twice, YO pull through all 5 lps. 2 sts dec.

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## DIRECTIONS

### Left Panel

Ch 111.

Row 1 (RS): HDC in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn. **110 sts.**

Row 2: Ch 1, (does not count as st throughout) HDC across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, DC in Flp across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, [FPDC around next st, BPDC around next st] across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, [BPDC around next st, FPDC around next st] across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, HDC B1p across, turn.

Rows 7–8: Ch 1, HDC across, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **108 sts.**

Row 10: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 3 sts, HDC-dec over last 3 sts, turn. **106 sts.**

Row 11: Ch 1, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **104 sts.**

Row 12: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 6 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 5 sts unworked, turn. **98 sts.**

Row 13: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **96 sts.**

Row 14: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 7 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 6 sts unworked, turn. **89 sts.**

Row 15: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **87 sts.**

Row 16: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 8 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 7 sts unworked, turn. **79 sts.**

Row 17: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **76 sts.**

Row 18: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 9 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 8 sts unworked, turn. **68 sts.**

Row 19: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **66 sts.**

Row 20: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 10 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 9 sts unworked, turn. **56 sts.**

Row 21: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in next 50 sts, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, turn. **52 sts.**

Row 22: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 7 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 6 sts unworked, turn. **45 sts.**

Row 23: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in each st to last 3 sts, HDC-dec in last 3 sts, turn. **41 sts.**

Row 24: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 7 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 6 sts unworked, turn. **34 sts.**

Row 25: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in next 28 sts, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, turn. **30 sts.**

Row 26: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 7 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 6 sts unworked, turn. **23 sts.**

Row 27: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in next 17 sts, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, turn. **19 sts.**

Row 28: Ch 1, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in next 8 sts, sl st in last 8 sts, working across angled side edge, ch 1, HDC evenly down side until you reach the foundation ch.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## Blissful Hair Towel (cont.)

### Right Panel

Ch 111.

Row 1 (WS): HDC in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn. **110 sts.**

Row 2: Ch 1, (does not count as st throughout) HDC across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, DC B1p across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, [FPDC around next st, BPDC around next st] across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, [BPDC around next st, FPDC around next st] across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, HDC Flp across, turn.

Rows 7–8: Ch 1, HDC across, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **108 sts.**

Row 10: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 3 sts, HDC-dec over last 3 sts, turn. **106 sts.**

Row 11: Ch 1, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **104 sts.**

Row 12: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 6 sts, sl st in next st, leaving rem 5 sts unworked, turn. **98 sts.**

Row 13: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **96 sts.**

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Row 19: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC across, turn. **66 sts.**

Row 20: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 10 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 9 sts unworked, turn. **56 sts.**

Row 21: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in next 50 sts, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, turn. **52 sts.**

Row 22: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 7 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 6 sts unworked, turn. **45 sts.**

Row 23: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in each st to last 3 sts, HDC-dec in last 3 sts, turn. **41 sts.**

Row 24: Ch 1, HDC in each st to last 7 sts, sl st in next st leaving rem 6 sts unworked, turn. **34 sts.**

Row 25: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in next 28 sts, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, turn. **30 sts.**

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Row 27: Ch 1, sk first sl st, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in next 17 sts, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, turn. **19 sts.**

Row 28: Ch 1, HDC-dec over next 3 sts, HDC in next 8 sts, sl st in next 8 sts, work across side edge, ch 1, HDC evenly down side until you reach the foundation ch.

Do not fasten off.

### Crocheting panels together

With the lp still on your hook from the right panel, place both panels together, with RS facing each other.

**Joining Row** (worked with WS facing out): Ch 1, turn, working through both thicknesses, SC evenly up right side angled edge, across top row and down straight left side edge to foundation ch (approx 160 sts). Turn inside out (joining row will now be inside). Straight left side edge seam becomes the center back side of the Turban.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Hang Tag

Ch 15.

Row 1: HDC in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn. **14 sts.**

Row 2: Ch 2, (does not count as st throughout) DC in Flp across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, [FPDC around next st, BPDC around next st] across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, HDC Flp across, turn.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew on the hang tag.

### **Attaching the Hang Tag**

Find the middle of the hang tag horizontally, then align the hang tag at the 12th row of the center back seam of the hair towel. With your preferred side facing out, whip st the two side edges of the tag onto the hair towel, creating a loop for tucking the hair towel into.
